Week 1- September 16

James 2:10 “For whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become accountable for all of it.”

Romans 3:20 “For by works of the law no human being will be justified in [God’s] sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.”

Genesis 8:21 “The intention of man's heart is evil from his youth.”

Week 2 – September 23

1st Commandment: “You shall have no other gods.” What does this mean? “We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.”

Psalms 14:1 “The fool says in his heart, ‘There is no God.’”

Romans 13:10 “Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.”

Week 3 – September 30

Matthew 22:37 “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.”

2nd Commandment: “You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.” What does this mean? “We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.”

Week 4 – October 07

3rd Commandment: Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.” What does this mean? “We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.”

Hebrews 10:25 “[Let us] not neglect to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encourage one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.”

Week 5 – October 14

4th Commandment: “Honor your father and your mother.” What does this mean? “We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.”

Week 6 – October 21

5th Commandment: “You shall not murder.” What does this mean? “We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.”

Matthew 7:12 “So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.”

Week 7 – October 28

6th Commandment: You shall not commit adultery. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.

Matthew 19:6 “So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.”

Week 8 – November 04

7th Commandment: “You shall not steal.” What does this mean? “We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.”

Week 9 – November 11

8th Commandment: “You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor” What does this mean? “We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.”

Week 10 – November 18

9th & 10th Commandments: “You shall not covet your neighbor's house.” “You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.” What does this mean? “We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.”

Week 11 – December 02

Galatians 5:13 “For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.”

What does God say about all these commandments? “I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate Me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love Me and keep My commandments.”

Week 12 – December 09

What does this mean? “God threatens to punish all who break these commandments. Therefore, we should fear His wrath and not do anything against them. But He promises grace and every blessing to all who keep these commandments.

Matthew 5:48 “You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.”

Hebrews 11:1 “Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.”

Week 13 - December 16

Acts 4:12 “And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.”

1 Timothy 2:5 “For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.”

Week 14 + 15 – January 06 + 13

The Apostle's Creed: I believe in God the Father Almighty Maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits on the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He shall come to judge the living & the dead. Week 16 + 17 – January 20 + 27

Hebrews 13:8 “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.”

The Meaning of the First Article: “I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses and still takes care of them. He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all that I have. He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life. He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil.”

Week 18 – February 03

(Review last week's memory on the 1st Article and add): All this He does only out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise serve and obey him. This is most certainly true.”

Week 19 + 20 – February 10 + 17

The Meaning of the Second Article: “I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity and true man, born of the Virgin Mary is my Lord, who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with his holy precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death,”

Week 21 – February 24

(Review last week's memory on the 2nd Article and add): “that I might be His own, and live under Him in His kingdom, and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness, just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.”

Week 22 – March 03

1 Corinthians 15:55-57 “O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting? The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

John 14:3 “And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.”

Week 23 – March 10

2 Corinthians 5:15 “He died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised.”

Titus 3:5 “He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit.”

Week 24 – March 17

Ephesians 2:8-10 “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.”

Week 25 – March 24

1 Corinthians 12:3 “No one can say, ‘Jesus is Lord,’ except in the Holy Spirit.”

1 Peter 2:9 “But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.”

Week 26 – April 07

Ephesians 4:3-6 “[Be] eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call—one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

Hebrews 11:6 “And without faith it is impossible to please God.”

Week 27 + 28 – April 14 +21

The Meaning of the Third Article: “I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength, believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; by the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith. In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ In the one true faith.”

Week 29 – April 28

(Review last week's memory on the 3rd Article and add): In this Christian church, He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers. On the Last Day He will raise me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Jesus Christ. This is most certainly true.”

Week 30 – May 5

2 Corinthians 5:21 “For our sake [God] made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.”

Job 19:25-27 “For I know that my Redeemer lives, and at the last he will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God, whom I shall see for myself, and my eyes shall behold, and not another. My heart faints within me!”

Week 30 – May 12

Matthew 10:28 “And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.”

John 10:27-28 “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand.”
